This allows them to bring to the residents of Mountrail County a full lab and radiology department that is here for your lab and X-ray needs. This is done through grants, private donations and the Reiarson Trust.

All labs, including urine and blood, can be completed here in Stanley, even if your provider is not local. The same is true for any MRI's, Ultrasound, Echoes, Mammograms, CT and X-Ray service needs you may have.

Hours for Lab and Radiology Services are Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM. It's nice to know you are coming ahead of time, but walk-ins are welcome for blood draws, urine and X-Ray's. You will need to have your doctor's order in hand or have it faxed over earlier to 628-3274 for lab and 628-3074 for Radiology.

MRI's, Ultrasounds, Echoes, Mammograms and non-emergent CT's will need to be scheduled ahead of time.

Please check in for any work to be done by the Lab and Radiology Department at the Hospital Admittance desk, located where the Mountrail Bethel Home, Mountrail County Medical Center Hospital/ER and the Business Office entrances meet up.

Services

Lab:

All labs, including urine and blood, can be completed here in Stanley, even if the provider is not local. All lab orders can be drawn at the Mountrail County Medical Center, processed and then sent out to the requesting provider.



MRI's/Ultrasounds/Echoes:

MRI's are available every Monday through DMS Health. Ultrasounds and Echoes are also available every Monday and Thursday through DMS Health. These are by appointment only. Please call 628-8629 for Radiology to schedule an appointment today.

EKG's:

EKG's can be done by your provider here in-house, if needed.

Radiology:

The Mountrail County Medical Center has been able to update it's stationary X-Ray machine and it's portable X-Ray machine due to grants provided by the Hess Corporation and private donors. These machines ensure the best quality picture with the least radiation possible to the patient.



CT Scanner:

We have an 80 slice CT-Scanner that was installed in 2022. This upgraded system provides faster scans with a more accurate image, so more detailed exams, low dose lung screening, and cardiac scoring can be done.





2-D and 3-D Mammography:

The Mountrail County Medical Center installed an in-house high definition Mammogram unit in 2018. The Mammomat Revelation provides the highest depth resolution on the market, with it's unique 50 degree wide angle tomosynthesis. And with it's personalized soft compression paddles, we can make the experience of a mammogram a positive one. Mammograms are by appointment only. Please call 628-8629 to schedule an appointment.
